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A Case Study on Yonivrana (Vaginal Ulcer)

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ABSTRACT

Vaginal infections are a burning problem in today's era. Vaginal discharges serve an important housewife function in the female reproductive system. It affects the whole reproductive as well as general health of the women. Ayurvedic texts have descried about various Sthanik Chikitsa for Yonigata Rogas. Despite wide range of treatment modalities in contemporary medicine search for safe option, non-surgical, effective and without any adverse effect is needed. This article describes the case report of 35yrs old woman who was complaining of vaginal discharge, itching at vagina. It was observed that Sthanika Chikitsa along with oral medications has provided significant relief in all symptoms.

There is reference of Yonivrana is available in Ashtanga Sangraha in the context of "Yoni Vranekshan Yantra". [5] The phenomenon, which causes the destruction of the tissue in a particular

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part of the body, is termed as Vrana.

CASE REPORT

A 35yrs old female Hindu patient, Housewife by occupation came to the OPD of Ayurvedic Hospital on 7/8/2018 with Complaints of Yonisrava, Yonikandu and Yonivrana since 2 months.

History of fever was there 15days back.

Past History: Patient was having same complaints since 2 months and she took contemporary medication for that but did not got relief. She was known case of Hypertension and on was Amlopin 5mg OD.

DISCUSSION

Chandranshua Rasa is used for the treatment of vaginal pruritis, infection and burning sensation. It balances Vata and Pitta. It has ingredients like Shuddha Gandhak, it has antimicrobial activity. Vanga bhasma is also mentioned in genito urinary diseases. Abhrak bhasma inhibits the growth of yeast cell.

Haridra Khanda is indicated in inflammatory disorder. Various ingredients of Haridra Khanda are having Vatashamak and Tridoshashamaka properties. It also act as blood purifier. Haridra is having the properties like Tikta Rasa, Katuvipaka, Ushnavirya, Laghu Ruksha Guna act as Lekhana Dravya. Digest the Aama, Kapha and Meda has anti-inflammatory and anti allergic effect. Other ingredients has Deepana and Pachana property.

Triphala Kwatha is anti-inflammatory, [5] antiviral, antibacterial [6] improves circulation and possesses astringent property. It also has *krimigna* [7] and *vranaropak* [8] properties. *Yonidhawan* [9] is one of the form of *Prakshalana* will clean the wound of vagina and washes out the secretions & discharges of the vagina. *Kashaya Dravyas* are having cleaning property and reduces the oozing from the wound. Jatyadi Taila Pichu helps the medicines to remain at the site for longer period for better action. Most of the ingredients of Jatyadi Taila are having Shodhana, Ropana and Vedanasthapana property. **ISSN: 2456-3110 CASE REPORT** Nov-Dec 2019

CONCLUSION

On the basis of above study it is concluded that, in Ayurveda there is no direct reference of Yonivrana. Yonivrana can be compared to Twak-Mamsajvrana. The internal medications like Chandranshua Rasa and Haridra Khanda along with Yonidhavan by Triphala Kwatha and Yonipichu with Jatyadi Taila provided significant relief in all symptoms of Yonivrana. No adverse drug reactions were noted during the study period.

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
