## Chatushka Methodology in Sutrasthana w.s.r. to Charaka Samhita

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### ABSTRACT

Ayurveda is the science of Life. It is oldest medical and Health science. It is not only preventive but also curative science. Charaka Samhita is one of the Classical text of Ayurvada. 120 Chapters of Charak Samhita are divided into 8 Sthanas. Sutrastana is one among them, which is placed first in Charaka Samhita. The methodology of Ayurveda living & the basic doctrine of Ayurveda which is its foundations are widely explained in Sutrastana. Sutrastana known as the Shira of Charaka Samhita. The essence of knowledge of the whole text is extracted in Sutrastana. Sutrastana is nectar of knowledge and is the collection of all basic subjects of Ayurveda. Chatushka methodology is adopted in Sutrastana. 30 chapters of Sutrastana are categorized under seven groups of four chapters known as Sapta Chatushka. Viz; Aushadha, Swastha, Nirdesh, Kalpana, Roga, Yojana & Annapana Chatushka. Here an attempt made the Chatushka methodology in Sutrasthana explained systematically and elaborately which gives fundamental knowledge for treatment.

#### INTRODUCTION

Ayurveda is the divine gift to mankind. It is transcended by Lord Brahma & taught to Dakshaprajapati. Dakshaprajapati taught Ayurveda to Ashwinikumaras. Ashwinikumaras taught Ayurveda to Indra, [1] from Indra Ayurveda delivered to the earth by the great effort of Bharadwaja.[2] Bharadwaja further taught Ayurveda to Atreya Punarvasu. Atreya Punarvasu gave the knowledge of Ayurveda to 6 disciples i.e. Agnivesha, Bhela, Jatukarna, Parashara, Harita & Ksharapani.[3] Agnivesha wrote a treatise

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named as Agnivesha Tantra. Acharya Charaka laborated Agnivesha Tantra which has become popular later as Charaka Samhita. It is redacted by Drudhabala.[4] Charak Samhita is divided into eight Sthana Sutrasthana, namely Nidanasthana, Sharirasthana, Indiyasthana, Vimanastana, Chikitsasthana, Kalpasthana & Siddhisthana respectively.[5]

The sequence of the 8 Sthanas in Charaka Samhita is of great significance. The thread used to tie many flowers together to make a garland similarly Sutrasthana comprises the meaning of all Sthanas in seed form. Sutrasthana is the section where a collection of various important Shlokas related to various contexts are described for which it is also known as Shloka Sthana. Sutrasthana is placed first as it is important like Shira i.e. Head of the body. [6] Sutrasthana is followed Chatushka methodology. The 30 chapters of *Sutrasthana* are categorized under the seven groups of four chapters known as Sapta Chatushka & the remaining two chapters dealt about the collection of information termed as Sangraha Adhyaya.<sup>[7]</sup>

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The Sapta Chatushka with name of Adhyayas is as follows:

- Asuhadha Chatushka deals with Deerghajivitiya Adhyaya, Apamargatanduliya Adhyaya, Aragwadhiya Adhyaya, Shadvirechana shatashritiya Adhyaya.
- Swastha Chatushka deals with Matrashitiya Adhyaya, Tasyashitiya Adhyaya, Navegan Dharaniya Adhyaya, Indiyopakarmaniya Adhyaya.
- Nirdesha Chatushka deals with Khuddaka Chatushpada Adhyaya, Mahachatushpada Adhyaya, Trishreshaniya Adhyaya, Vatakalakaliya Adhyaya.
- Kalpana Chatushka deals with Sneha Adhyaya, Sweda Adhyaya, Upakalpaniya Adhyaya, Chikistaprabhrutiya Adhyaya.
- Roga Chatushka deals with Kiyantashirasiya Adhyaya, Trishothiya Adhyaya, Ashtodariya Adhyaya, Maharoga Adhyaya.
- Yojana Chatushka deals with Asthoninditiya Adhyaya, Langanabrumhaniya Adhyaya, Santarpaniya Adhyaya, Vidhishonitiya Adhyaya.
- Annapana Chatushka deals with Yajjapurishiya Adhyaya, AtreyaBhadrakapiya Adhyaya, Annapana Vidhi Adhyaya, Vividhashitapitiya Adhyaya
- Sangraha Adhyaya deals with Dashapranayataniya Adhyaya and Arthedashamahamuliya Adhyaya.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Charaka Samhita Sutrasthana is that section where a collection of various important subjects are present, which are dealt elaborately in Sapta Chatushka. The Sapta Chatushkas are as follows;

Aoushad Chatushka - which deals with chapter 1 to 4. In this section the description of basic principles of Ayurveda i.e. Shatpadarth, Tridosha, Rasa, Dravya etc. & description about various drugs which are useful for Antahparimarjana & Bahiparimarjana Chikitsa are mentioned.

- Swastha Chatushka Aim of Ayurveda is Aturasya Vikara Prashamanam & Swasthasya Swasthasya Rakshanam. First four chapters explaining the treatment under Aoushdha Chatushka. Swastha Chatushka is explained for maintenance of health. It deals with chapter 5-8. In this many advices mentioned which are required for maintaining health of individuals by proper knowledge of Ahara, Vihara, Natural urges, Sadvrittapalana etc.
- Nirdesh Chatushka deals with chapter 9 to 12. In this many important information & directions for treatment is described. Chikitsa Chatushpada, normalcy & abnormally of Tridosha with Guna, Trividha Eshana, Astha Trika are explained.
- Kalpana Chatushka deals with chapter 13 to 16. In this number of formulations and their method of preparations, various treatments have been explained. In last chapter of Nirdesh Chatushka i.e, in Vatakalaakaliya Adhyaya explanation of types of Dosha, properties are mentioned. Kalpana Chatushka explains different formulation in respect to Doshika condition of body & Disease. Snehana is considered as best treatment for Vata Dosha, so Kalpana Chatushka started with Sneha Adhvava followed bv Sweda Upakalpaniya & Chikitsa Prabhrutiya Adhyaya give knowledge of rules & regulations to be followed after Shodhan procedures management of complications due to Shodhanadi procedures.
- Roga Chatushka deals with chapter 17 to 20. In this various types & number of Disease are mentioned. In previous Chatushka Acharya Charak mentioned about medicine, which is administered with respect to diseases. In the Roga Chatushka various diseases have been explained. Kiyantah Shirasiya Adhyaya focused the diseases of Marmas, hence started with Pradhana Marma i.e. Shiro Roga followed with Hrudaya Roga,18 types of Kshaya, Madhumeha etc. In Maharoga Adhyaya Nanatmaja Roga of Tridosha along with Tridosha Chikitsa Sutra is explained.

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- Yojana Chatushka deals with chapter 21 to 24. In this various types of ways of treatment procedures & criteria for selection of patient for treatment is described. This Chatushka has been explained to fulfil the adaptation of particular type of treatment in individual. Line of treatment of diseases varies from person to person, so Yojana Chatushka started with the explanation of Nindita Purusha. Shadvidha Upakrama is explained in next chapter.
- Annapana Chatushka The Chikitsa get influenced by Ahara, thus Annapana Chatushka is explained next to Yojana Chatushka. It deals with chapter 25to 28. In this various types of food, food materials & various ways of preparing food are mentioned. Hitakara Ahara does proper nourishment of body, where as Ahitkara Ahara is responsible for origin of disease. Detail explanation of Ahara is present in this Chatushka.

#### **CONCLUSION**

By the above discussion it is concluded that a *Pranabhisara Vaidya* should have the knowledge of *Sapta Chatushka* in *Sutrasthana* of *Charaka Samhita*. And for better applicability of fundamental concept in clinical practice, understanding the science contextually and thoroughly is necessary. The 30 chapters of *Sutrastana* are categorized under seven groups of four chapters known as *Sapta Chatushka*. Viz; *Aushadha, Swastha, Nirdesh, Kalpana, Roga, Yojana* and *Annapana Chatushka*.
