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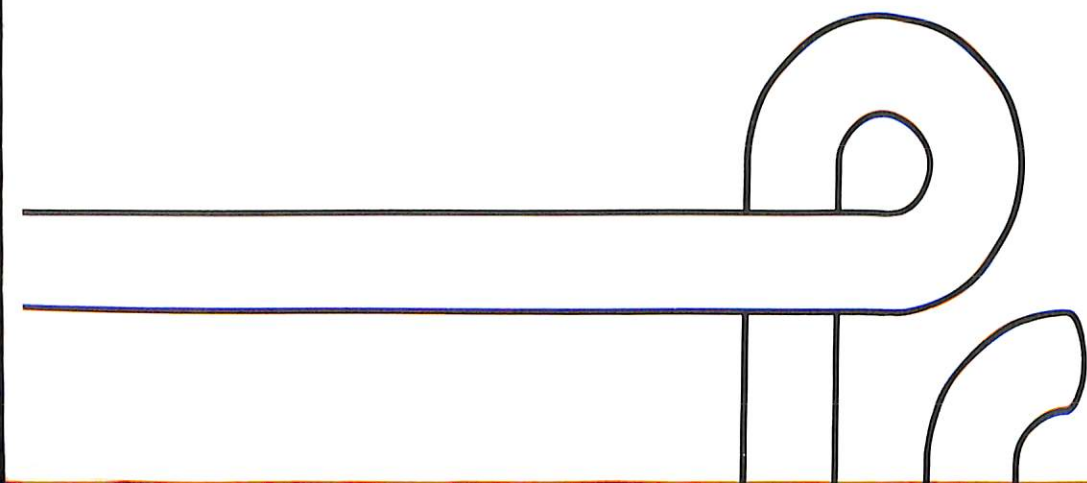

In the past quarter century it has developed from a one-man department to a teaching staff of twenty-five, plus a dozen graduate teaching assistants. A student has the choice of concentrating in a large selection of studio disciplines on both the undergraduate and graduate levels. In Art History an undergraduate program is offered.

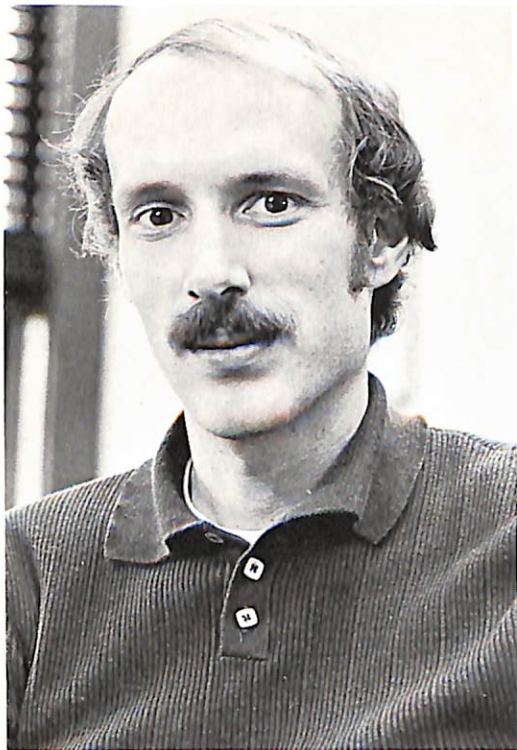

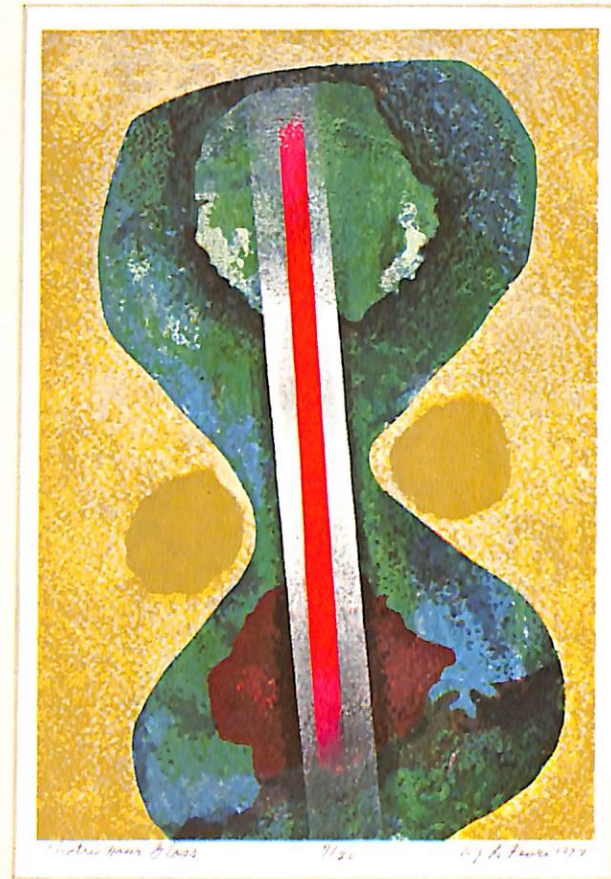

Fragment of a Landscape 30"x40"

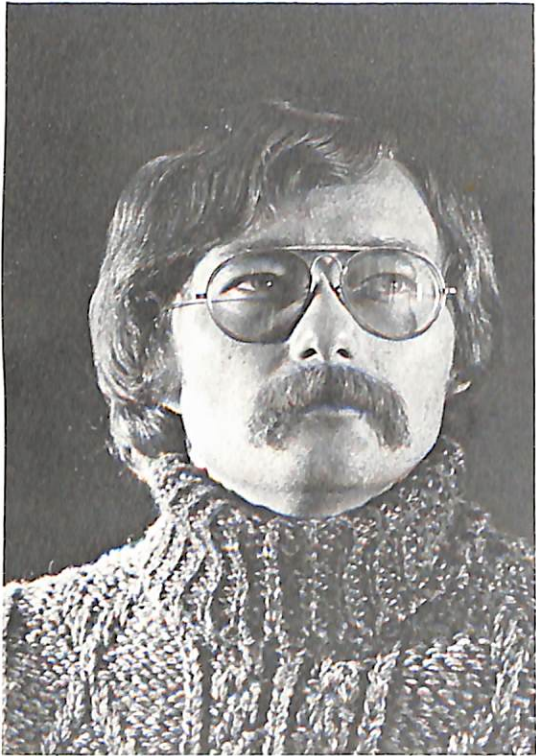




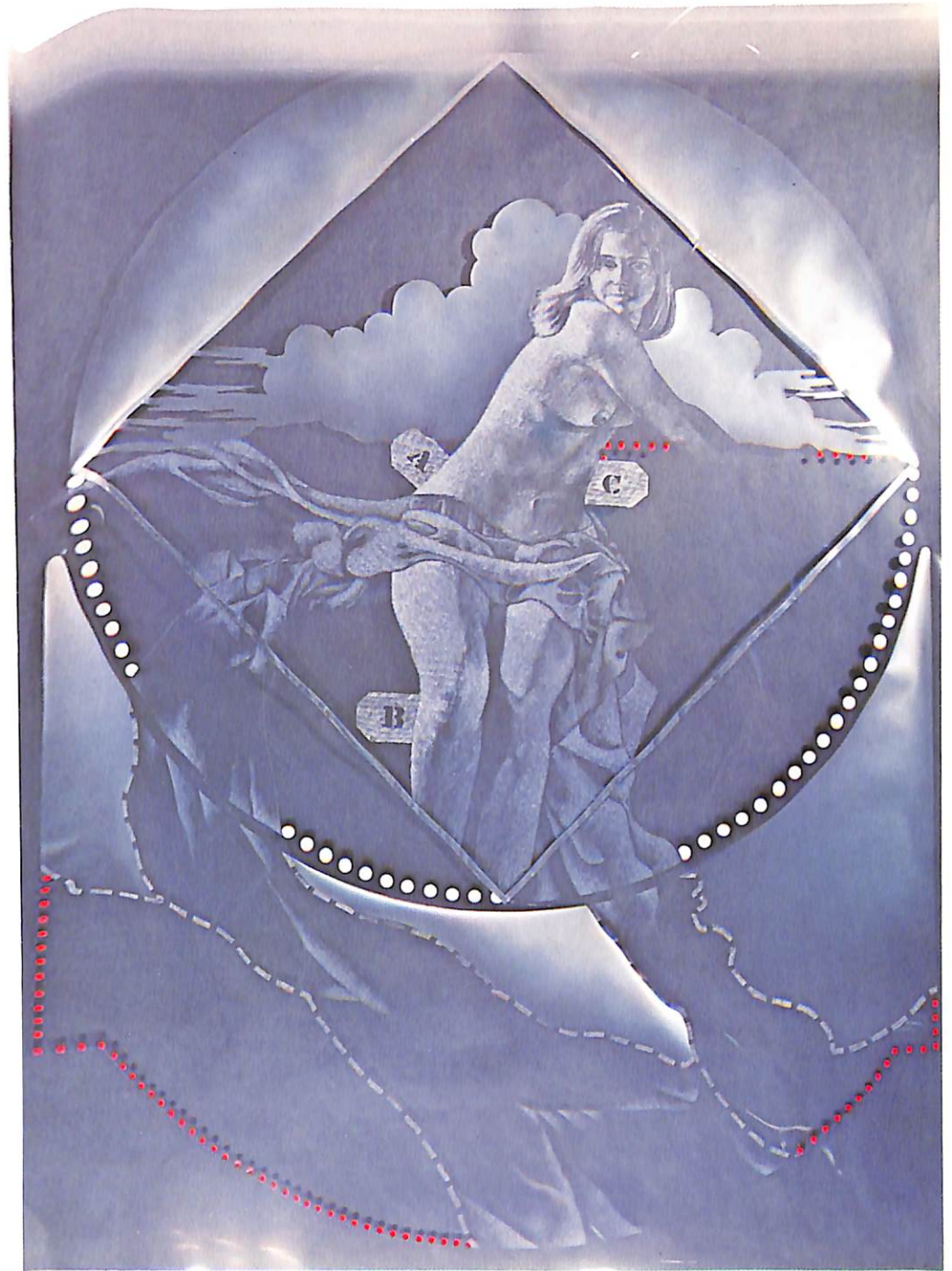
