It was a holy man, a man of God, Jesus of Nazareth. I'd heard of him. Well, I had a friend, you see, Marcellus, we'd gone through the academy together. Marcellus was based in the Galilee as a military governor. He'd become a worshiper of the God of Israel, very active in their synagogue. He had a servant. Well, his best friend, really, his servant had had been a slave child in his father's household.

They had grown up together, played together in school together. When he became an adult, Marcellus had set his friend free, but his friend had chosen to stay with them was the steward of all his lands. So friend was dying. Marcellus had heard of this. Oh, no, no, master, said Marcellus, I'm not worthy to have you in my house while he was a gentile.

went to his head pretty well.

The Jews have a king Caesar as their king. All right, I said get on with it.

That they had already got on with it by troops were Syrian mercenaries, they hated the Jews,

him made of crown of thorns, vicious thorns landed on his head. The blood was running down

and they'd dressed him in an expensive purple robe. I don't know who they stole it from. Take

that stuff off him, I said. And they were they took it off.

You take the turbulence and the horizontal piece, tie it back behind the shoulders, tie the arms back so that when they carry it, they stagger under the weight of it. Their arms are tied back so they can't protect themselves. They're like a little baby. Everybody laughs at them. They're helpless. When they fall. They can't help themselves. They just smack the whole body into the ground.

Jesus kept falling. He had been badly beaten. Finally, I could see he couldn't go on.

There was an African man in the crowd, a pilgrim from Cyrene. I said, Carry his cross. Came to the place of execution, Golgotha, the Jews called it good name, place of the skull. We would say Calvados in Latin. Well, there we crucified him. Standard procedure. Take one of those iron

spikes in all those iron spikes that we use in the main beams of our houses. Drive it between the bones of the wrist. Never crucify a man through the hands.

Won't take the weight. No to the bones of the waist and the of the wrist. And then the weight of the body will hold, you see. Well, as the spike was driven in, his whole body convulsed and he cried out. It's funny, I hadn't noticed until that moment he hadn't said a word. They always spoke when they knew they were going to be crucified. Yeah, they always had plenty to say. I'm innocent. I'm innocent.

So I'll do a deal with you. I'll take you to every bandit hideout in the hills. If you'll let me go, they'd curse us. They'd curse their own God for saving them. They always spoke when they knew they were going to be crucified. Jesus hadn't said a word until a spike was driven in that it cried out. Daddy, forgive them for they know not what they do.

Other are met a spike, lift him up onto the cross here, the pope, as the arms come out of the joints, take the feet, put him in the crouch position, drive the other spike home, always crucify a man in the crouch position. We see people think you die on a cross because you bleed to death. You don't bleed that much. Once the spikes driven and it seals the wound, you know, you die on a cross because you can't breathe with your body stretched out like that and the weight on it, you put him in the crouched position, then they can push themselves up to breathe because they they have to press on the spike. It's quite clever, really.

We don't torture them. They torture themselves. They don't want to they want to die. But you can

choose not to breathe. They'll fight for breath as long as they can for days. Sometimes when we

want to kill them, we break their legs with a club and they can't lift themselves up. They die right

away. Well, Jesus hung on his cross, doing whatever a crucified man does, he breathed.

Agonizing breath after breath, hour after hour.

About three hours went by, it's funny, it started growing dark was the middle of the day, a lot of

people became frightened and left. A doubt that had been looking at a group of people on the

edge of the crowd, some women, one young man. I heard him cry out to them, to a woman,

behold your son, son. Behold your mother.

And I thought to myself, hmm. He may be just a Galilean peasant, but he has no

ability. He he's dying on a Roman cross and he's thinking of his mother he's caring for. I was

impressed by that. We Romans, we we understand. We we admire that kind of courage. Another

hour went by, cry it out again, I'm thirsty. I heard him say, oh, that was predictable. They always

got thirsty on.

There were some women there. They came to all the crucifixions. They would bring cheap wine

mixed with narcotic herbs to dull the pain. One what my trips took a sponge, put it on the end of

a spear, lifted it up to his lips, but he turned his head away. So when he realized what it was, he

would have no part of it. Another hour went by to.

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Saw him lift himself up, raise his head as though he were looking off into the distance to the very end of the world, and I heard him cry out in a powerful voice. It's done.

You're dying on a Roman cross. You're as helpless and defeated as any man could ever be. What have you done?
