

Semecarpus impressicostatus

ABSTRACT

Semecarpus impressicostatus is restricted to the Telupid-Tongod area in eastern Sabah. The estimated area of occupancy (AOO) and extent of occurrence (EOO) are 12 km² and 779 km², respectively. It is known from three sites, two of which are within Totally Protected Areas (TPAs), however, forest fire remains a threat to these individuals as the sites are close to the border of the reserve. Land use change is a major threat to the subpopulation outside of the protected areas. Hence, it is assessed as Endangered. *Semecarpus impressicostatus* is endemic to Sabah, Malaysia. It is restricted to the Telupid-Tongod area in eastern Sabah.
