Department of Otorhinolaryngology & Head and Neck Surgery in Sestre milosrdnice Clinical Hospital Center is the oldest ENT department in Croatia, and in the Southeastern Europe, and amongst the oldest ENT departments in the world, continuously working from 1894. Extremely significant and excellent results of this ENT department in otorhinolaryngology are presented in 15 chapters and 112 pages of the monograph "125 GODINA OTORINOLARINGOLOGIJE U VINOGRADSKOJ BOLNICI 1894. – 2019.", which is published on the occasion of celebrating the 125th anniversary of this ENT department.
