



- Creating innovative, flexible and context specific business incubation and youth entrepreneurship development services
- Promote and celebrate women and youth champions to create social influence and positive mindsets
- Develop individual and collective agency of women and youth



Quick-win actions for best results



- Innovative **financial services** for the youth
- Continuousness backstopping and coaching support and business development services for the youth
- Market linkage facilitation support for the youth
- Capacity development for inclusive engagement
- Monitor and mitigate unintended impacts on women, such as increased work burdens, ownership shifts, loss of women's innovations or spaces, etc.
- Create knowledge and technology-driven livestock enterprises and employment and entrepreneurship opportunities for the youth
