<b>District:</b> Edinburg CISD <b>School/Campus:</b> South Middle School
<b>Teacher:</b> Sylvia M. Rodríguez
<b>Date:</b> July 21, 2021
<b>Subject and Grade Level:</b> World History, 6 <sup>th</sup> Grade
<b>Materials:</b>  Pictures of Freddy Gonzalez's Letters. PowerPoint Presentation with information Graphic Organizer with Questions
<b>TEKS (Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills):</b>  2A, 2B, 19B, 21BCD
<b>Lesson objective(s):</b> 1. The Learner Will (TLW) analyze and explain the cause and effects of the Vietnam War. 2. TLW analyze and explain the letters of Freddy Gonzalez and how he played a part in the Vietnam War.

### **Differentiation strategies to meet diverse learner needs:**

**The teacher will make an individual copy of the graphic organizer for each student.**

**The teacher will give extra time to accommodate certain students.**

**The teacher will allow group work and partner work.**

### **ENGAGEMENT**

- Describe how you will use place-based and/or culturally relevant pedagogies to promote student engagement?
- What kind of questions should the students ask themselves after the engagement?

**The teacher will begin by reading orally to the class the last letter written by Freddy Gonzalez to his mother.**

**Discussion will take place after the letter is read.**

**Questions to ask:**

**How does this letter make you feel?**

**How was he feeling during the time he wrote the letter?**

### **EXPLORATION**

- Describe what place-based hands-on activities you could use to encourage students to engage the content.
- List "big idea" conceptual questions related to the content you can use to encourage students' exploration of the lesson.

**Inquiry Based Learning:**

**TLW research why Freddy Gonzalez "Road" was named after him and why Freddy Gonzalez Elementary was named after him.**

### **EXPLANATION**

- What questions could you pose to students before you proceed to introduce the topic, themes or key terms?
- What questions or techniques will you use to help students connect their own knowledge to the main topic and/or key concepts under examination?
- List higher order thinking questions you could use to solicit participation and engage students in discussion and provide their own interpretations.

**The teacher will explain facts about our local hero "Freddy Gonzalez" and the cause and effect of the Vietnam War by using a PowerPoint Presentation.**



## Lesson Plan

### ELABORATION

- Describe how students will develop a more sophisticated understanding of the topics, themes or key concepts.
- What vocabulary will be introduced and how will it connect to students' observations and/or personal knowledge?
- How will this knowledge be applied in their daily lives?

**TLW participate in learning stations and engage pictures and information on the Vietnam War, Freddy Gonzalez, and his letters and answer comprehension questions on their graphic organizer at every station.**

### EVALUATION

- How will students demonstrate that they have achieved the lesson objective? This should be embedded throughout the lesson as well as at the end of the lesson.

**TLW answer an exit ticket question and a few students will explain their answer.
