

Dear Mr. Leath:

Your letter of May 31, 1966 has been received. I have checked the obituary notices in the Biblical Recorder to 1907; the obituary notices in the Convention minutes, and the Kings Mountain associational minutes without finding anything. The file card for B.W. Bussey contains only the information that he was in Shelby in 1884. The card for J.M. McManaway mentions that he was at Wilson in 1884; Tarboro; and then Shelby with no dates for the last two. There was a cross reference to Thomas J. Taylor's A History of the Tar River Baptist Association, 1830-1921 from which an xerox copy of the biographical sketch is inclosed. I am sorry that I could not be of more assistance to you.
