#### ABSTRACT

A survey was conducted to assess student satisfaction of the Counseling Education program at the University Texas of the Permian Basin. The survey was given to currently enrolled counseling education students. Fifty-seven out of 68 students completed the survey. Several recommendations were made based on the results. Overall, the program is perceived as adequately meeting the satisfaction of the students.
