In the House of Representatives, February 11<sup>th</sup> 1785

The Committee appointed to consider the Resolutions  
of Congress of March 23<sup>rd</sup> and April 19<sup>th</sup> 1784

Report

That the recommendation con-  
-tained in the first of the said Resolutions is founded on  
the 5<sup>th</sup> Article of Confederation, and should be complied  
with, as far as the Circumstances of this State will  
admit.

The Committee therefore are of Opinion that  
the next Delegates to be appointed to represent this  
State in Congress, should be empowered by Commissions  
under the Great Seal, to act until the first Monday  
in next November.

And to obviate the inconvenience  
which may arise from the State being at that time  
left unrepresented, the Committee recommend that  
a Clause be inserted in the Commissions to the future  
Delegates, authorizing them to act in Congress until  
they shall be relieved by the Legislature of this State.

The Committee are further of opinion it is ex-  
-pedient that not less than three<sup>rd</sup> Delegates appointed by  
this State should attend their duty upon the floor of  
Congress.

Resolved, That this House do agree in the above  
report
