We have examined the Papers of the late Superintendant of Finance in this Office, relative to the supplies furnished by the State of South Carolina in the years 1782 & 1783. and have the Honor of laying before the Committee Copies of the following Papers, for their Information on this Subject. In our Letter to Congress of the 22<sup>nd</sup> June last we only  
stated the sums which had been paid to the credit of the  
State of South Carolina in the Books of the Treasury  
viz<sup>t</sup> 373.590 Dollars on the Requisition of 1782 — for  
8.000.000 D<sup>rs</sup> — and 41.916. — on the Requisition of Two  
Millions of Dollars Exclusive of these sums, Accounts  
of supplies furnished by the State of South Carolina  
have been examined at the Treasury (though not  
entered) to the amount of D<sup>rs</sup> 115.658.20. as per the  
Registers abstract herewith transmitted. —
