The above I sent for^t to Mr. Le Roy on 12 June 1801 to be held in trust for you & also nine U.S. Bank Shares I have since your Letter seen Mr. Le Roy. he says the fund^d debt, was not transferred to his name, but the 9 Bank shares were, of course I must have rec^d. the interest blended with my stock last quarter, but I cannot find your Certificate & suppose you must have them among your papers pray search & let me know if you have them otherwise they are lost. Your interest on last Quarter will be as above D^{ts} 72: 80 for which I have sent you my check at foot hereof -

I am to have for a a month past nearly, been so ill, that I
cant hold up my head, if you find these Certificates they must be
transferred to Mr. Le Roy's name, or some one else, as I am too ill to do any
