State of New Jersey

An act to authorize Peter Mean to fulfil the last will and testament of Peter Van Burgh Livingston esq. deceased

Whereas William Edgars and Charles Ludlow, executors and Cornelia Livingston executrix of the last will and testament of Philip Livingston esq. late of the city of New York surviving executor of the last will and testament of Peter Van Burgh Livingston deceased, and others the devisees of the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston have by their petition, represented that there is property in the state of New Jersey belonging to the estate of the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston, remaining unsold and undisposed of, and that by reason of the demise of the aforesaid Philip Livingston, surviving executor of the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston and of the non age and absence of many of the representatives of the devisees of the said Peter Van Burgh, the will of the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston cannot be fulfilled. Therefore

It is enacted by the Council and General Assembly of this state and it is hereby enacted, by the authority of the same That the lands and real estate whereof the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston died seized, which remain unsold and undisposed of by the executors or surviving executor of the said Peter Van Burgh Livingston and the same are hereby vested in Peter Mean of Ursino, in the town of Union, county of Essex and state of New Jersey, with power to sell and dispose of the same or any part thereof in fee simple, and to execute good and sufficient deeds therefor to the purchaser or purchasers, which deeds of conveyance so to be executed by the said Peter Mean, shall operate to convey to the grantees therein named respectively, all the estate right title and

interest, which the said Peter Keanburgh Livingston had
in the said lands at the time of his death, and the said
Peter Kean is hereby ordered and directed to divide and
distribute the net proceeds of such sales, and of all monies
that may be paid into his hands on account of the estate
of the said Peter Keanburgh Livingston (after deducting
all necessary expenses that may attend the execution of
this trust) from time to time as he may receive enough
to make a reasonable dividend thereof, among the
devises or their representatives of the said Peter Kean
burgh Livingston, according to the directions and true
intent and meaning of the said last Will and Testament
of the said Peter Keanburgh Livingston. Provided
That before the said Peter Kean, shall take upon himself
the execution of the powers vested in him by virtue
of this act, he shall execute a bond to the Governor of this
state, in such sum and with such sureties as shall be
approved of by the Orphans Court of the county of Essex
for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him
by this act, for the use benefit and security of the heirs
assigns and legal representatives of the said Peter Kean
burgh Livingston, deceased, their heirs assigns and legal
representatives respectively.
