of Elizabeth Town in the county of Essex & State of  
New Jersey am held and firmly bound unto Eleanor Wilson  
Nicholas Arrowsmith & Nicholas A Wilson of the same  
place Executors of James Wilson Deceased in the sum  
of One thousand Dollars good and lawful money of the  
United State to be paid to the Said Executors or their  
certain attorney or attorneys their executors admin-  
istrators or assigns to which payment well and truly  
to be made I bind myself my heirs Executors and  
administrators Sealed with my seal, dated this four-  
teenth day of December 4 4 4 in the year of  
our lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty Nine

The Condition of this Obligation is  
such that if the above named Daniel Conklin his heirs  
Executors or administrators do well and truly pay  
or cause to be paid to the above named Eleanor Wilson  
Nicholas Arrowsmith & Nicholas A Wilson executors  
as aforesaid their executors administrators or assigns  
the sum of Five hundred Dollars in One year from  
the above date with Interest payable half yearly  
then this Obligation to be Void otherwise to be and  
remain in full force and virtue 4 4 4
