
That We Jane Grove and John Kean

Executrix and Executor of the last Will & Testament of Sam. Grove  
late of S. Helena Parish Granville County State aforesaid  
Merchant deceased  
For and in Consideration of the Sum of Twenty five thousand  
pounds lawfull

current Money of the State  
aforesaid to us or one of us in Hand paid at and  
before the Sealing and Delivery of these Presents by John  
Faucheraud Grimké Esq. of Ch. Town in the  
State aforesaid the Receipt whereof do hereby  
acknowledge, have bargained and sold, and by these  
Presents do bargain, sell and deliver to the said John Faucheraud  
Grimké all those Negroe Slaves known by the names following viz:  
London Cuffy Ludjoe John Sancho Cera Glover Celia Doll Cloe  
Hannah Betty Casar Chance Sarah Bess Cato Edinborough Primus  
Sampson Peter June December Sandy September October  
Billy, Guinea Peter, Kate Affy Flora Minnah Moll Pender Venus Bella  
Lettice Ben Rinah Bess Little Venus Mariane Bosan & Joe  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said Negroe Slaves & the  
future Issue & increase of the said female Slaves

unto the said John Faucheraud Grimké his  
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to his and their  
only proper Use and Behoof for ever. And We the said  
Jane Grove & John Kean for ourselves  
and each & every of our Heirs, Executors and  
Administrators, the said bargained Premises unto the said  
John Faucheraud Grimké

his Executors,  
Administrators and Assigns, from and against all Persons  
shall and will warrant and for ever defend, by these Pre-  
sents. IN WITNESS whereof We have hereunto set  
our Hands and Seals Dated at Charlestown  
on the first Day of January in the  
Year of His Majesty's Reign and in the Year of our  
Lord 1778.
