John Kean of Beaufort in the State
aforesaid the Receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge, have bargained and sold, and by these
Presents do bargain, sell and deliver to the said *John Kean*

All those several Negroe Slaves named as follows viz
Cato Sampson Sandy Guinea Peter September June
Edinborough Sancho December Primus Cera Goster
Kate Affy Flora Minna Moll Peter Venus Lettice Doll
Hannah Ben Joe Rinah Venus Mariare & Bess

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Negroe Slaves*
& the future Issue & increase of the said female
Slaves

unto the said *John Kean* his
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to his and their
only proper Use and Behoof for ever. And *I* the said
John Faucheraud Grimke for myself

my Heirs, Executors and
Administrators, the said bargained Premises unto the said
John Kean

his Executors,
Administrators and Assigns, from and against all Persons
shall and will warrant and for ever defend, by these Pre-
sents. **IN WITNESS** whereof I have hereunto set
my Hand and Seal. Dated at *Charlestown*
on the *first* Day of *March* in the
~~Year of the King's Majesty King George the Third~~ Year of our
Lord 1778.
