Grove of Beaufort in the State aforesaid.

the Receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge, have bargained and sold, and by these
Presents do bargain, sell and deliver to the said *Jane Grove*
all those several Negroe Slaves known by the Names
following viz: *London Cuffy Rudjoe John Peter
Billy Bosan October Celia Betty Cloe Fanny
May Bella Caesar Chance Sarah Bess & Paddy*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *Negroe Slaves
& the future Issue & increase of the said
Female Slaves*

unto the said *Jane Grove her*
Executors, Administrators and Assigns, to her and their
only proper Use and Behoof for ever. And *I the said*

John Faucheraud Grimké for myself
my Heirs, Executors and
Administrators, the said bargained Premises unto the said
Jane Grove

her Executors,
Administrators and Assigns, from and against all Persons
shall and will warrant and for ever defend, by these Pre-
sents. **IN WITNESS** whereof I have hereunto set
my Hand and Seal. Dated at *Charlestown*
on *the first* Day of *March* in the
~~Year of His Majesty's Reign, and in the~~ Year of our
Lord 1778
