Board of Police Letter

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The State of Mississippi Board of Police
 Lenoir County Monday April 3. 1865

To James Sykes, E. P. Odumal, John M. Witherspoon, Thomas C. Billups & George N. Harris.

At this meeting of the Board you were appointed Commissioners & are hereby authorized and directed to let out the building of a Bridge across McGowan Creek on the Moore Road to the lowest bidder at the earliest day practicable:

And you are to require, as one of the conditions of the Contract, of the Contractor to have the bridge completed within such time as you may prescribe.

And when said Bridge shall have been completed you are to inspect the same & make full written report thereof to the Board: And when the said Bridge shall have been received and the Contractor or builder shall have entered into Bond with approved security in double amount of his bid, conditioned to keep said bridge in good repair for the term of six years from the day of completion, then the Clerk shall issue him a warrant for the amount of his bid, payable out of the County Treasury.
