I hope you have had good weather for the Hay cutting. It has been pretty and fair weather over here.

I failed to say anything about where to get the Wire for the baling of the Hay. You can get it any where in Terry that you can find it and have it charged to me. I will pay all when I come over there either Friday or Saturday of this week. You might just shock the Hay in large piles and have it baled next week if you think well of it. Do the best that you can so as not to lose any time.

I am going to ship Pump Stand from here and you might go to town after it Saturday.
