Dear Cousin

I have been wanting to write to you for some time but I have been sick for a week. Mr John Sellers is mighty sick now. I would not be a bit surprised to hear that he was Dead this morning. Pa went over there last night to set up. he has not got back yet. Mr Ballas Lake Died a few days ago with Pneumonia. Pa got back a while ago. and said Mr Sellers was better this morning. I hope he will get well. I have been sick with

Cammie you must write
soon and tell me all the news.
Pa is teaching School now
he has 27 or 8 dollars, we
will finish ~~the~~ bedding up our
corn land in one or two days.

soon, I give my love to all,
write soon to.
