

DECEMBER 2002 SENIOR SERVICE AWARD SERAH MAKKA

Serah Makka has been selected by the University of North Florida Alumni Association as the recipient of the Senior Service Award for the December 2002 graduating class. The UNF Alumni Association selects a graduating senior each semester for outstanding service to the University or the community through volunteerism.

Serah Makka came to UNF in the spring of 1999 and is graduating today with a degree in Economics and International Studies with a 3.86 GPA. Since August 2001, her professional experience has included serving as an author/researcher in the UNF Undergraduate Enrichment Program, working as a field researcher in the Center for Student Success and Retention and most recently, interning at Harvard University in the Center for International Development. In addition to her academic work, Serah has logged numerous hours in volunteer service.

Serah has become well known on the UNF campus and in the community. As president of the Golden Key International Honor Society, she has participated in numerous community service projects such as the Books and Bears drive to benefit children with pediatric AIDS, canned food drives, an International Business Learning Project with area elementary school children and countless service projects that benefit Jacksonville's homeless. She has been an active member of several UNF organizations including the Resident Student Association, the International Student Association, the

Undergraduate Enrichment Honor Society and volunteers as a Victims Advocate for the UNF Women's Center. Serah also served as Vice President of the African Students Association. During her tenure, she concentrated on urging the UNF community to understand the culture of Africa and primarily, Nigeria. Her platform "upholds the necessity and beauty of diversity and understanding diversity." Within the Jacksonville community, Serah has volunteered with the Arlington Assemblies of God, the Nigerian Association of Jacksonville and at the Micro Credit Campaign Economic Summit.

Although Serah feels that all volunteer experience is important, her most rewarding work was with children with pediatric AIDS. The epidemic is eradicating the psychologica and economic framework of Africa, so the experience hit closer to home for her. Serah states: "we might not be able to protect their bodies from the disease process but we can intervene. As a society, we need to shield their hearts in a scabbard of love, in a sheath of acceptance, in a calabash of enduring hope."

In all, Serah has logged countless hours of volunteer community service. She has definitely made an impact on UNF's campus and in the community of Jacksonville. Well rounded, selflessly driven, and generous, Serah embodies the spirit of University of North Florida students and alumni. She truly characterizes what the Senior Service Award represents.

TRADITIONS OF THE COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY

Academic regalia date to European universities of the Middle Ages, when gowns and hoods were required for warmth in unheated buildings. Gowns were furlined adaptations of the priestly toga, and hoods were worn to protect the tonsured heads of the priests. The regalia now serve as a visible reminder of the historic antecedents of intellectual pursuits.

In American universities of the late 19th century, these medieval costumes were revived to lend color to academic functions. Efforts were made to establish a code that would set standards for academic dress. Gowns of masters and doctors are generally ankle length and closed in front. The master's gown has pointed sleeves that are slit at the elbows. The doctoral gown has wide lapels of velvet, either black or the color of the scholar's specialization. The sleeves are full and bellshaped, with three velvet chevrons, either black or colored like the lapels. Gowns normally are black, although some universities have designed their own in the colors of the institution.

The hood, which drapes over the back of the gown, carries the greatest symbolism of all components of the academic costume. Its length, width and colors denote the wearer's highest academic achievement and institution. The master's hood is pointed; the doctoral hood is bellshaped. The color of the border of the hood indicates the scholar's major field of study; the lining color or colors identifies the institution that conferred the wearer's degree. Hoods were originally trimmed in fur, but now have satin borders for masters' and velvet for doctors' hoods.

The customary head covering is the mortarboard, or Oxford cap, with a tassel on the left side. Persons who possess the doctorate wear a tassel of gold metallic threads. The soft, large beret, modeled after the cap of Cambridge University, also has been adopted by some institutions.

The medieval university was much concerned with rank and privilege, and academic robes made visible the social and academic distinctions of the wearers. These distinctions have largely disappeared, and robes now indicate specialization. The following colors are associated with the degrees frequently represented in academic processions:

THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH FLORIDA

The University of North Florida (UNF), one of 11 public institutions in the State of Florida, is a comprehensive urban university that offers degree programs at the bachelor, masters, and doctorate levels. Established in 1965 as an upper division and professional graduate institution, the University began offering classes in 1972. Freshmen and sophomores were added to the student body in 1984. UNF's scenic campus is now nestled among 1300 acres which includes a nature and wildlife area with lakes and nature trails.

The University is accredited by the Commission on Colleges of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (1866 Southern Lane, Decatur, Georgia 30033-4097: Telephone number 404-679-4501) to award the Baccalaureate, Masters, and Doctor of Education Degrees. Some professional associations offer further accreditation of specific programs. UNF programs in building construction management, business administration, computer science, electrical engineering, music, nursing, nutrition, physical therapy, public administration, sports medicine/athletic training, and teacher education have been accorded national accreditation.

As UNF grows, it is proud of maintaining a reputation for excellence which attracts a diverse group of highly qualified students. The Fall 2002 freshman class had a mean SAT score of 1136.95 and a grade point average of 3.55. The minimum scores typically expected for admission are a sliding scale equivalent of 1000 on the SAT (or the ACT equivalent) and a GPA of 3.0. Twenty percent were in the top 10 percent of their graduating class. Minority students comprise 21% of the student body. International students make up nearly 2% of the mix: 243 students from 66 countries around the world. 59.5% of UNF students are women; the average student age is 25.46.

Academic programs are built on a strong foundation in the traditional arts and sciences. The University now has a student body of over 13,600 students enrolled in 49 undergraduate degree programs with 92 areas of concentration, 24 masters degree programs with 49 areas of concentration, and one doctoral degree. It has 432 faculty and more than 800 full-time and part-time staff. UNF now grants over 2,200 Bachelor, Masters, and Doctoral degrees each year through its Colleges of Arts and Sciences, Coggin College of Business, Education and Human Services, Health, and Computing Sciences and Engineering.

UNF is dedicated to excellence in teaching, research, and public service. The University's faculty is committed to providing high-quality instruction, with particular emphasis on undergraduate education. The faculty's publications and other creative activity demonstrate a determination to remain at the cutting edge of intellectual inquiry and practice in their respective disciplines. The University — through centers and institutes as well as traditional educational offerings and activities — is a major contributor to the community life of northeast Florida and, indeed, to the larger community.

Through the strong support of the University of North Florida Foundation Inc. and the generosity of both corporate leaders and dedicated citizens of Florida's First Coast region, UNF now has four Eminent Scholar Chairs: the Andrew A. Robinson Chair in Educational Policy and Economic Development, the Ira M. Koger Chair in American Music, the Prime F. Osborn Chair in Transportation, and the Paper Plastics Education Research Foundation Endowed Chair for Supply Chain Management. The UNF Foundation, funded by contributions, supports a wide range of UNF's activities on campus and in the community.
