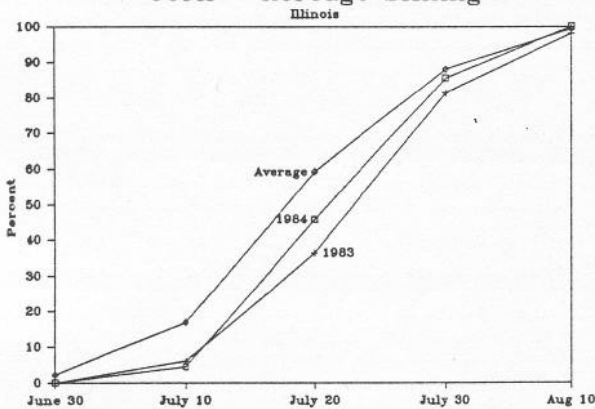

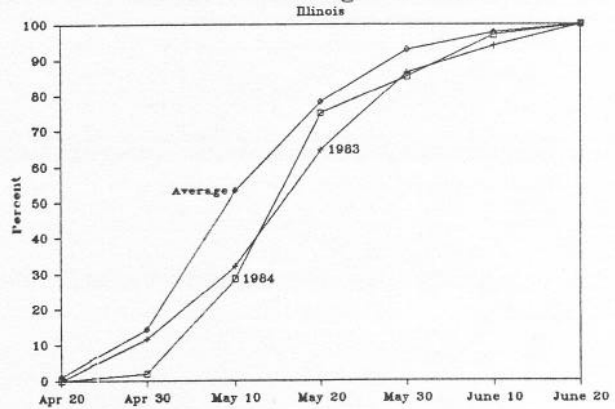

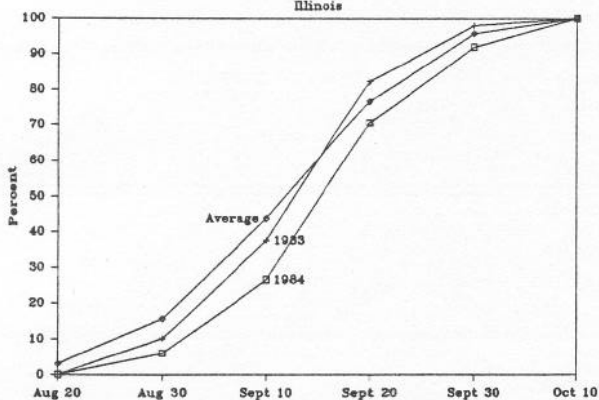

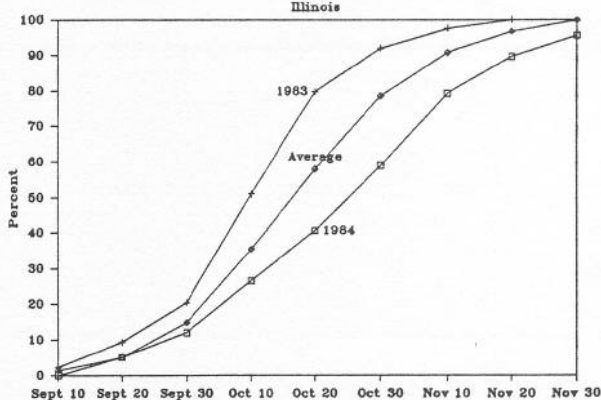

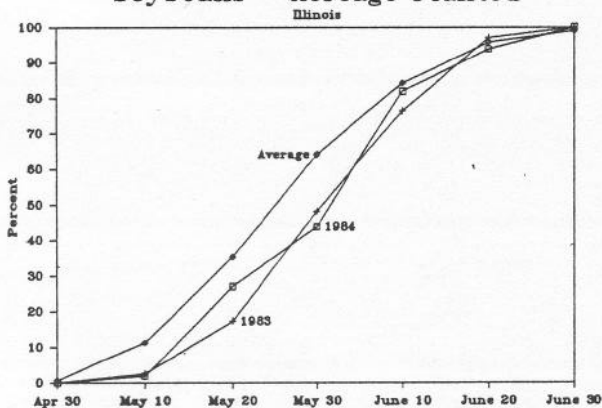

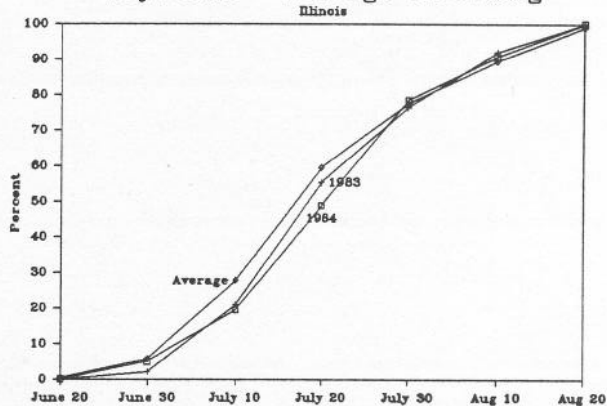

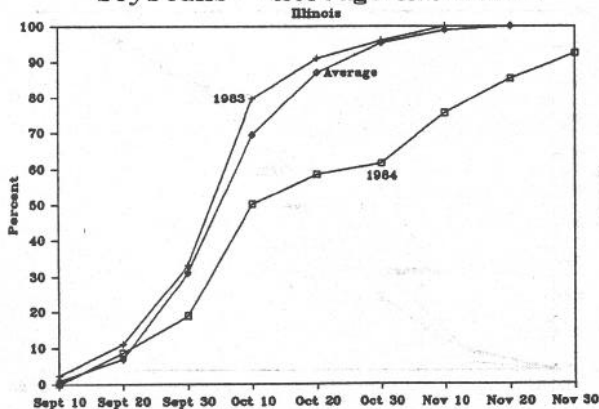

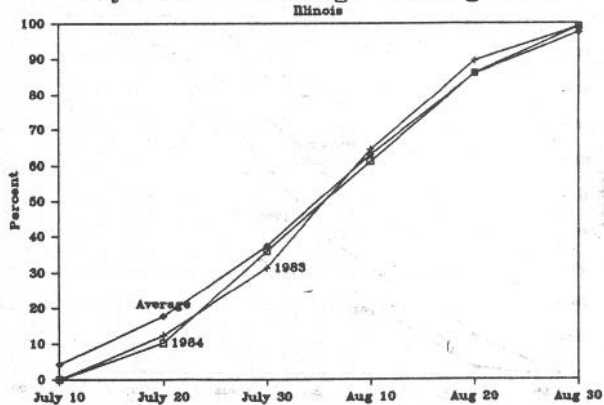

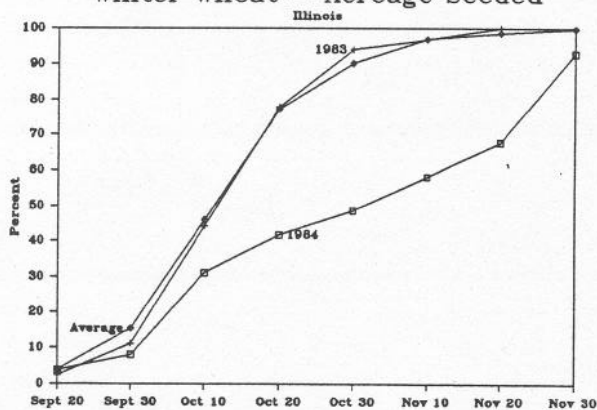

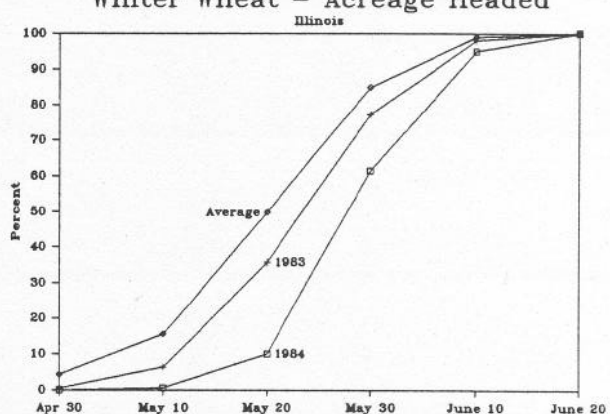

Winter Wheat - Acreage Headed



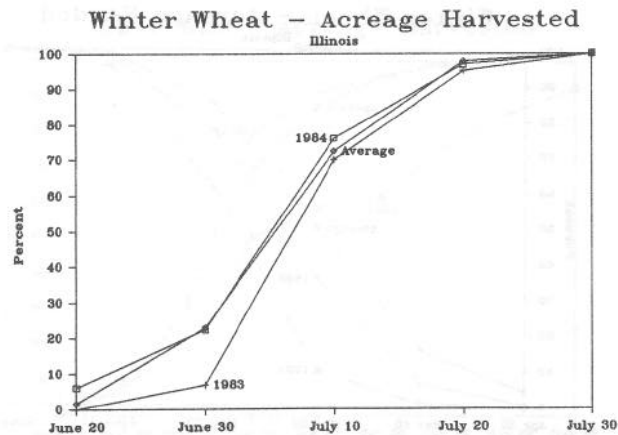
