ORDER

Defendant's Motion for Stay Pending Appeal is denied, except as to attorney fees.

This appeal has slight chance of success. All major legal issues in this matter have already been resolved by prior appeals in this case. No proof was presented on the merits following remand. Only discretionary equitable relief consistent with established Title VII precedent has been ordered. Any stay of the equitable relief, regardless of the outcome on appeal, will require further hearings on relief and further uncertainty.

Attorney fees, which were awarded by agreement and not the subject of any proof, are stayed provided defendant posts a cash or surety bond before July 1, 1990 in the amount of \$500,000.
