

**Framing of Design** Technology is the solution

Adjusting individual behaviors while perhaps acknowledging systemic issues

# **Design Outcome**

Centered around symptoms of systemic issues without awareness of larger structures

Techno-fixes that prioritize appearance, perception and feeling rather than material changes to inequity

# Justice Oriented

information extraction

Designer is responsible for redistributing design authority to those most impacted by the problem space

Designer intentionally listens for expressions of pain rooted in inequity and seeks to ensure that design authority is shared

Systemic issues are recognized and contextualized through codesigner engagement

Systemic issues are contextualized through codesigner engagement and activist texts to inform solidarity consciousness

Rooted in the desires of the codesigners

A design space affording collective action with clear goals for structural change, with codesigners as project stewards
