PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS, the United States Marine Corps Aviation Arm has distinguished itself for courage and performance of duty throughout the world above and beyond the normal call of service; and

WHEREAS, the Marine Corps contemplates certain public demonstrations in Maine during the coming week; and

WHEREAS, the State of Maine would join in tribute to these valiant defenders of our liberties and those of all the peace-loving peoples of the United Nations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SUMNER SEWALL, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby proclaim the week of August 3 - 8 as Marine Aviation Week in the State of Maine, and urge upon all its people that they wholeheartedly join with the Marines in making these activities here highly successful.
