Dr. Sir

Daniel R. Leather of this  
town a private of Comp. D,  
1<sup>st</sup> Reg. of Maine H. Artillery  
Capt Crossman commanding,

dated Aug 22<sup>nd</sup> 1863. He is  
sick unable to return at  
the appointed time & I would  
recommend that he have his  
furlough extended <sup>30</sup> days longer  
at which time I will report  
his exact condition unless he is  
then able to return to his Company
