The bearer, Mr Artemus Robinson ~~is~~ first sergeant of Company E. 4th Me Vols at the battle of Bull's Run, was taken prisoner at that battle, was released 3^d June of the present year, remained at Governors Island (N.Y) two months & has since been at home on parole. He is quite popular among the mechanics & labourers around here & I think if he could be detailed for the recruiting service, that the Quota of troops for the town in this vicinity might be raised more readily than they would be with some other men as recruiting officers. I have no doubt that many volunteers would come forward at once if it was understood that they could serve in a Company where Robinson had a commission.
