Oct. 19th 1861

Dear Sir.

Yours of the 12th inst. is at hand and I take the first opportunity to answer: —

I was aware that our Descriptive Roll which was made amid hurry & confusion required an apology.

The new Roll which you require shall be promptly forwarded; but as our Roll was lost in the battle of Bull Run and some of the men have been transferred to other companies it will be necessary that we have a copy of the Roll which you have: if you will be kind enough to cause a copy to be forwarded

I will immediately have a
correct one sent to your Dept.

If find it will be absolutely
indispensible & shall wait till
the same can be received, &c
