Sir; Several individuals from Gardiner have represented to me at different limes that there was a prejudice existing in that City against In alword which delired men from enlisting Konowing that Mayor Woods was laking a lively interest in the matter of entirements and was also a friend to Lieut alwood, I wrote him gesterday asking what the state of Jeeling was, I if enlistments would go on more rupilly

under other Circumstances. this reply, with his furnission, I send with this, Last evening & met Mayor woods at a muling of the Citizens of that Iclaco Vastew him of the forejudice would not in a day or lus be umoved, the reflict to me that altho he had the highest Confidence no Mo Movods ability to acquit himself will as an officer. & altho the Jerequelico had little foundation, it was encreasing rather than diminishing. He also stated that he thot their quota Could not be felled ander present circumstances, astrul me to lay the Case refore you.

It is my desire & curnesteffort to perform the duty you have apigned me namely to fill the company. From the disposition which has bun made of other lowns on the County, it will be effected that we Should draw largely whom Tardiner for Loldins. I reget the hindrance and afam you that I furgome This delicate last without prejudice to any, Jam Sir. Your Soll. Dervent
