Getting an iTunes U Site


- Creating a Team

- Collecting/Building Content
 - Audio
 - Video
 - PDF/ePub Files

Building Your Site

- Private site to start off
 - Same features as a public site, for you to develop in and build up a library.
- A library must have approximately 100 pieces of educational content, and meet Apples design requirements to become publicly listed in their directory.
- You can run private and public sites to provide faculty with the option to keep content private or open to the world.




To access the content for your course, click the Category it falls under on the right!




Go Apple...Conform

 - Authors
 - Topic
 - Clean/Not Clean
- Don't take content down after a course has run!

Getting to iTunes U:

Download and install iTunes.

Open iTunes and click the "iTunes Store" menu item in the left


pane.



Click "iTunes U" along the menu at the top of the store.



- Getting to a Specific Institutions iTunes U Page
 - Enter the main iTunes U site
 - Click "Universities and Colleges" on the right side of the window.



 Pick the school you want to view (I recommend Bristol Community College!)

Apply for your own iTunes U Site
