ANDERSON, CARL Sr.

Carl Anderson was born April 17, 1867, in Degerfors, Sweden. His parents were Carl and Anna (Johnson) Anderson. As a youth he attended the public schools and after graduation accepted a job in an ore mine.

In 1899 Carl married Johanna Swanson. Shortly after their marriage they came to the United States. After their arrival in New York they came directly to St. Cloud. Mr. and Mrs. Anderson made their home with Albert Johnson, a friend from Sweden, until they erected a home of their own. Carl then accepted a job as a stone cutter which trade he followed until his death, November 10, 1923.

Carl and Anna (Swanson) Anderson were the parents of one son, Carl Jr. He is married and lives in St. Cloud.

Anna (Swanson) Anderson now makes her home in Dassell, Minnesota.
