



The Misadventures of Dirty Dan Vol. 1




3 YEARS LATER





Inside of Dirty Dan we see what is happening. The bacteria is causing tissue damage in the lungs! There is significant scarring and bleeding in the lungs!



Finally Dirty Dan visits the doctor and gets an X-ray to find the cause of his ailments and to receive treatment!



Because Dirty Dan's TB might be drug resistant, he is prescribed numerous antibiotics like isoniazid, rifampin, ethambutol, and pyrazinamide across a 6-9 month treatment period.



9 Months Later




Unfortunately Dirty Dan's medicine doesn't work, his strain might be resistant to most antibiotics used to treat TB!!!


Try these!

Amikacin

Dirty Dan's TB has caused full blown necrosis in the lungs! Large cavities filled with pus have formed and there is a lot of pulmonary bleeding! Dirty Dan's lungs are about to fail!



Oh no! Even the newest and best drugs failed and Dirty Dan still has TB!



Even second-line antibiotics are failing. We'll try countering drug resistance with Bedaquiline. Remember, all TB medication can be toxic to your liver, so stay on the lookout for nausea, vomiting, loss of appetite, jaundice, dark urine, easy bruising or bleeding, and blurred vision.
