The man Brady, I spoke to you about, from Mandan, is still getting Booze from Yates, but who ever takes it down, goes by way of Baker or Marmouth, and does not come through our County. Is there no way that you can put some one on his trail at Mandan? I am almost sure that he has a fresh load there now, as the man Albrecht that I told you about was here last night and my self and Deputy stayed in the Bad Lands all night, but he did not come that way, and he could not go through without we would see him, and I am sure he was here for no other purpose than to get Booze.
