WHEREAS, the Maine Elks Association, a benevolent organization interested in the welfare of the community and its underprivileged and handicapped children; and

WHEREAS, there is currently a lack of summer programs and facilities for the handicapped, both physically and mentally; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the membership of the Maine Elks Association to establish a summer camp for said handicapped;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kenneth M. Curtis, Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby proclaim the month of October as
