

WHEREAS, speech, language and hearing disorders constitute this nation's most widespread handicapping conditions; and

WHEREAS, some 24 million Americans, about 10 percent of the population, or an estimated 122,792 people in Maine have speech, language or hearing impairments which affect their educational, vocational, personal and social functions; and

WHEREAS, most people with communication disorders can be helped by speech-language pathologists and audiologists, but often need to be made aware of the availability of services; and

WHEREAS, Better Hearing and Speech Month is an annual national campaign to inform the public about communication disorders and ways to get help, and to encourage early detection, proper treatment and prevention of these disorders,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOHN R. McKERNAN, JR., Governor of the State of Maine, do hereby proclaim May, 1993 as

throughout the State of Maine.
