PROCLAMATION

BY THE GOVERNOR

To the Members of the Kennebec and Somerset County Committees of the Democratic Party Residing in Senatorial District 23.

GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, by the withdrawal of Matthew C. Levine of Winslow in the County of Kennebec, he having been duly nominated in the Democratic Primary Election of June 13, 1978, as a candidate for election to the office of State Senator in District 23, a vacancy now exists, and

WHEREAS, 21 M.R.S.A. Section 1474 provides that if a person nominated for election for State Senator at a regular primary election dies, withdraws or becomes disqualified, the Governor shall issue a proclamation declaring the vacancy, ordering the appropriate political committees to fill it, and setting a time and place for the committees to meet, and

WHEREAS, I have been officially informed of the withdrawal of said Matthew C. Levine,

NOW, THEREFORE, I do hereby direct that the Democratic County Committee Members residing in Senatorial District 23 meet in Detroit on Sunday, September 17, 1978, to nominate their candidate for the office of State Senator to be voted for at the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 1978. A certificate of choice of said nominee shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of State forthwith.

You the said members in conducting said meeting and in making your records and returns of the same, are hereby directed to comply fully with all the provisions of law relating to the proposal of candidates for election as provided by said Title 21, M.R.S.A.
