Esrenada. Pauline - you are all

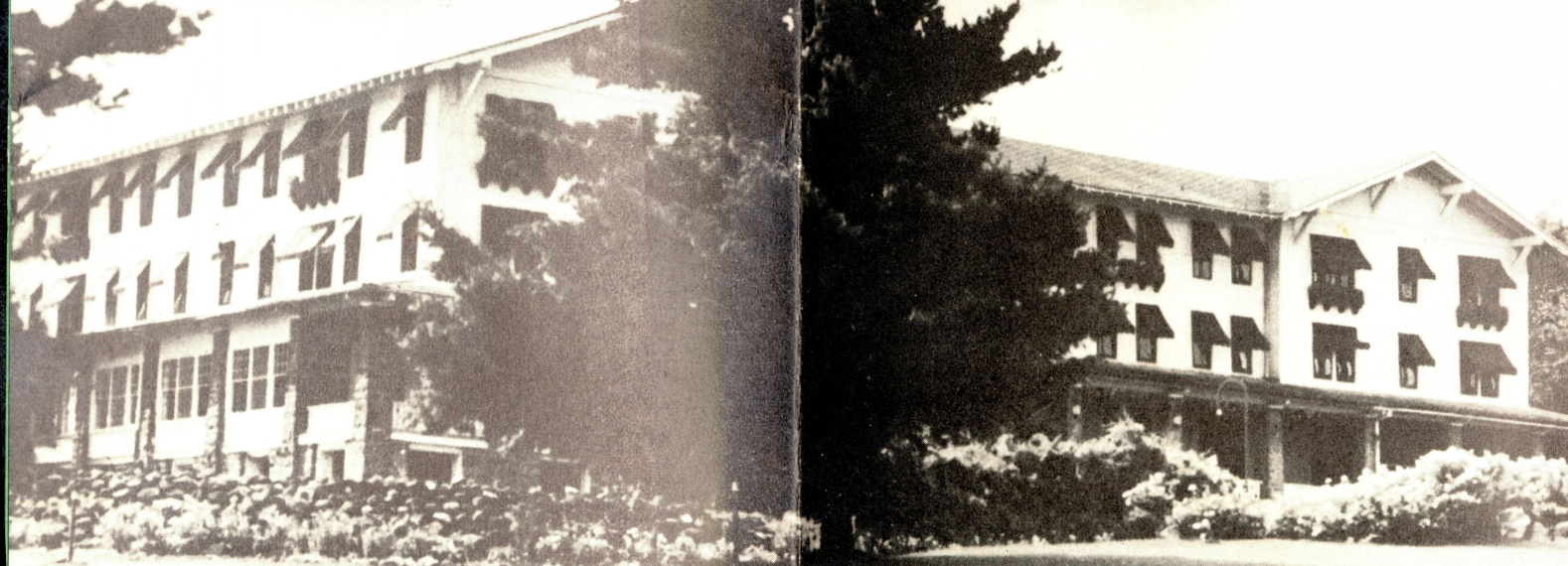


So very dear to me. more like

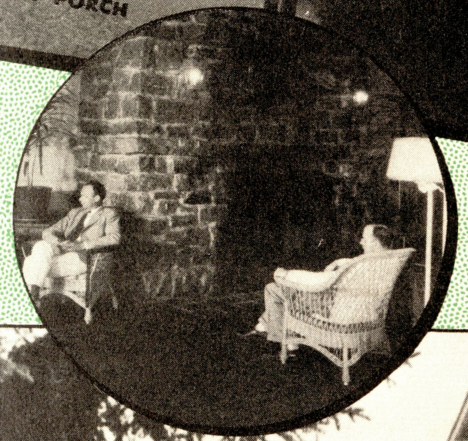

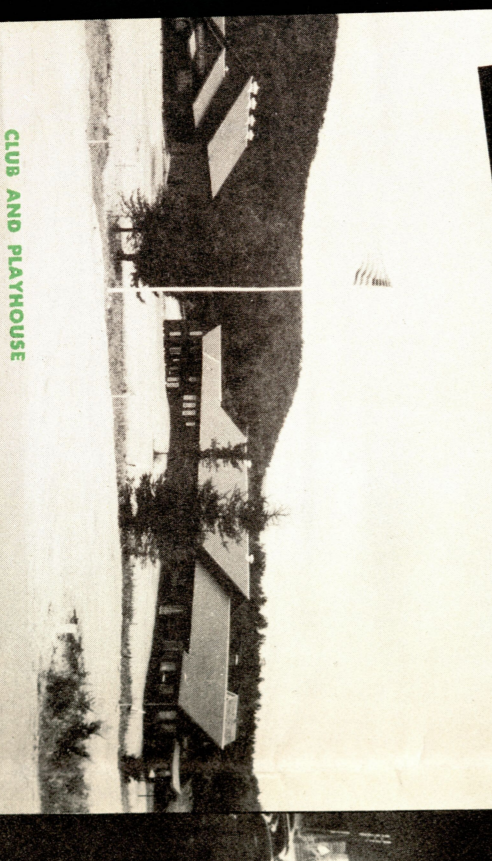

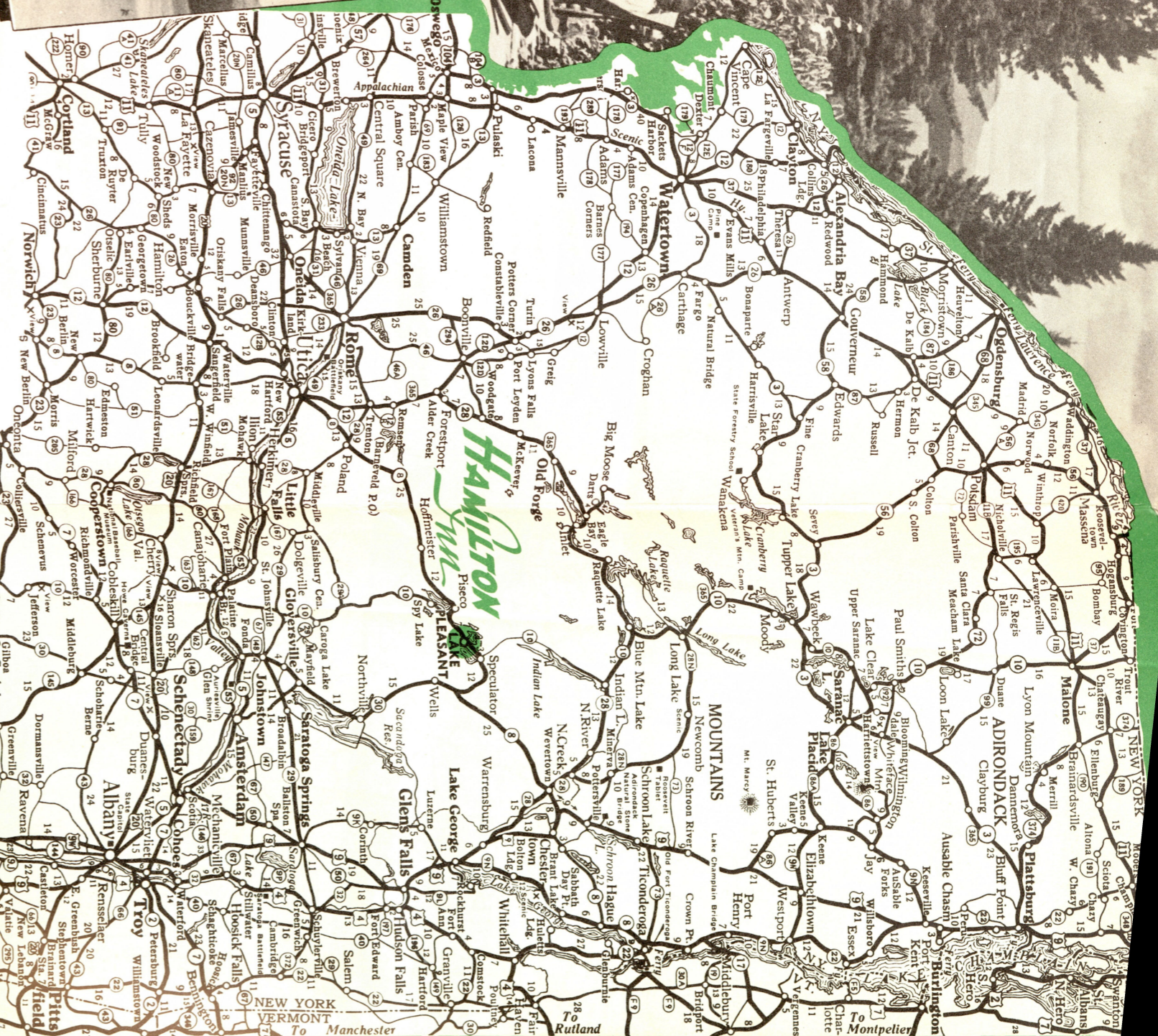
