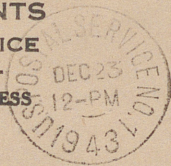

My darling - Italy  
Two days more, and it will  
be Thanksgiving, and that will mean a  
lot of me because of you and Stan  
both being here, and getting along so  
nicely. However, to the soldiers it will  
be just another day - all the days  
don't alike with nothing special added  
to any of them. I haven't been getting  
my mail from you lately - just a  
few letters that struggle in the  
terrible though is on this side, because  
of so much mail coming in and their  
inability to handle it all. I received  
two packages yesterday, one from Mother  
and one from Sister. Both had ties, socks  
and handkerchiefs and of which I have so  
much I don't know what to do with.  
It's hard to pack much clothes around.  
I wish someone would break down and  
send me some cigars. Kisses and hugs from  
you and I love you and think of you  
constantly. Rollin
