North Africa
Sept 11, 1943

My darling

all the news I had to tell you I wrote day before yesterday so today it will be scarce. I can truthfully say that Saturday afternoon here is not like the Saturday afternoon in the states. That was something we looked forward to, but here it is just another day.

I forgot to tell you the other day in my last letter when I was talking about sending you money, that in the near future you will receive a check from the finance dept. The check will cover travel allowance allowed you from ~~Cairo~~ our last station in Adfhera to Tajela. I directed the finance dept to mail you the check, just send it to Aunt Annie for deposit.

Most of the crowd have gone swimming this afternoon - I will go somewhere tomorrow. The swimming here is fine, and really does you a lot of good.



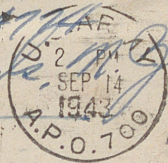
