North Africa
Sept 6, 1943.

My darling —

This country is certainly hot in the day time, but delightful at night for sleeping. I don't believe the hottest state there can compare with this heat. I would give most anything for a good drink of water because this water tastes like salts, and does not quench your thirst.

I have seen quite a few interesting things since I have been here, and I am quite surprised over some of them. I will have plenty to tell you some day. These people over here are quite interesting, especially the Arabs.

We don't get to bathe over here very much - had a very good bath the other day at the Red Cross. It will have to look me for a week. I didn't know you could miss one quite so much.

There is no news to tell you except I am getting along fine, so don't worry about me. How have you been feeling lately, and have



you had any trouble at all. I want to know all these things.

Have you managed in the apartment yet, and are you satisfied with it. I am sure it will be the best, and you will be happier.

Take good care of yourself because I love you very much.
