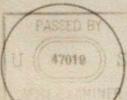

March 18, 1945

Your v. mail of Feb 22 came day before yesterday. Thanks a lot, Honey. You've been swell to write when you are so busy. I believe I've already told you that I got the stove, haven't I? Thanks again, Sis. Those sleeping socks that you sent while I was in England have been life savers. A couple of my toes were frost bitten and if I hadn't had those socks that would have been plenty of night's that I didn't do much sleeping. You guessed wrong on us building those bridges, Sis. I was afraid all of you thought we were in on that. Hope you have some idea of where I am by now. One of the USO Camp shows played for us last night. Got an M.C., dancer, singer, and comic juggler, but they put on a real show. You can't give those people too much credit. If you haven't sent the cigs. don't. Because we are getting plenty now. Thanks anyway, Sis. Love you

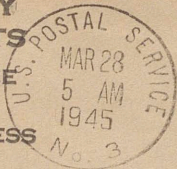
