On the 1st profino, the Head Guarters of the District of Florida, and the Office of the Reit Commissioner of the Bureau of Refugees. Freedmen and Abandoned Jande, will be establish ed at St. Augustine Fla. to which place all the records and property appertaining to each Department will be removed. II. The Past at Tallahassee Ala, will be reduced to two Companies, Viz: Company 9:34 8. y " 21. S. Infantry, Company A'y " 21. S. Infantry will proceed to and take Post at St. Augustine Fla without debay. MI. The building near Fallahassed, known as the Commepany Store House will be so arrang ed as to store supplies, and altered in such a manner as to accomodate the crooks, and the Gaspital The ground now occupied by the ofthe Infantry Camp will be relinguished on the 1st proximo, and the temporary Carracks removed to the vacant grounds in the vicinity of the Commissary Store House IV. The building hered as a Haspital is Tallahassee, will be relinguished on the 1. profins, and the sick together with the necessary supplies for the Post transferred to the temporary Gaspital, all stores

and property oper and above those required for the two Companies at Sallahasses will be sent to the Depot at Jacks onville.

V. all rented grounds, Store Houses Excepting the Suberstance Store House, Work Shops, Dwellings, Stables and Offices will be nelinquished to their proper owners on the 1. proximo.

II. There will be retained at the Gost, three horses and Equipments for Express purposes, One Wagon and team to supply detached bamps, and one for The use of the Post, all other quarter master's Stones and property will be sent to the Depot at Jacksonville, The surplus Commissary Stores beyond the wants of the Companies will be sent to Depot at Jacksonvillo Ha That in future requisitions for supplies of all kinds, Quarker Masker Commissary and Hospital for the Commans at Tallahassed will be made upon that Depot.

VIII. S. Cal. F. J. Flint y th 21. S. Infantry will continue in Commant of the Past at Sallahassed, and is charged with the elecution of the foregoing, which should be accomplished before the 1st proximo In addition to the duties of the Past of Col. J. J. Flint will exercise a supervision over the Counties of Jakeden, Beliefy, Fackson and Calhoun, and a general observation, over the affaire of the Bureau of Befugees, Incedmen and abandones and and will make the necessary reports to these stead Quarters whenever he may deem it necessary
