You will please Seal it and present it to the Board at the proper time. Should the Board fix the salary of the Engineer at 2000 \$ pr. Annum, it will be approved by the Executive. I have directed the Secretary of State to Notify each of the Directors of the time and place of Meeting.

The Gentleman nominated as Engineer comes highly recommended to the Executive as well qualified in every respect for the office.
