Too often too many take too much for granted. Your dedication of "The Pulse" to the people of Vermont is concrete evidence that this is not true at the Medical School.


Vermonters take pride in their Medical School. They take pride in its accomplishments and satisfaction in the contribution its graduates have made in attending to the miseries of poor health.




Greetings:
