PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Nova Southeastern University will be celebrating its 50th birthday on December 4, 2014 as a graduate institution in the physical and social sciences; and

WHEREAS, in 1972, the university introduced its first off-campus course of study in education, soon becoming nationally recognized for its innovative distance education programs; and

WHEREAS, Nova Southeastern University is one of only 311 colleges and universities, out of more than 4,000, that was nationally selected by the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching to hold a dual designation of both "high research" and "community engaged"; and

WHEREAS, today, Nova Southeastern University employs more than 4,000 people, and has an economic impact on the Sunshine State of \$2.6 billion; and

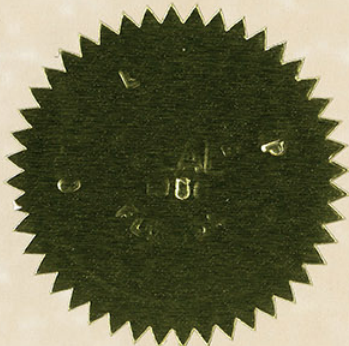
