- Reliving a past era

(societal hierarchy)
- Descartes' ideas

Personal Interpretation

- Discretion of the reader
- Visual imagery & the imagination
- Inferred tone of situation

Personal Expression

- Political
 - ex. Henrik Ibsen's *Enemy of the People*
- Engagement with the piece
- Embodiment of the text

Linguistic Aspects

- Language and movement combined to form expression
- Play on words – everything is metaphorical
- Evolution of language – 18th century to present day
 - “Que Votre Majesté ne se mette pas en colère”

Comprehension

- “Breaking the Barrier”
- Quicker and Longer Retention
- More Intimate Understanding

Vocabulary

- Enables Expansion
- Facilitates Associations
- Quicker Understanding
- Long-term Retention

Pronunciation

- Aids with pronunciation of new words
- Aids in orthography of new words
- Subtle vowel differences
 - “mourir” vs. “murir”

Interest

- Sparks Curiosity
- Scratches the Surface
- Relatable and Applicable
 - ex. *History of the Peloponnesian War*
