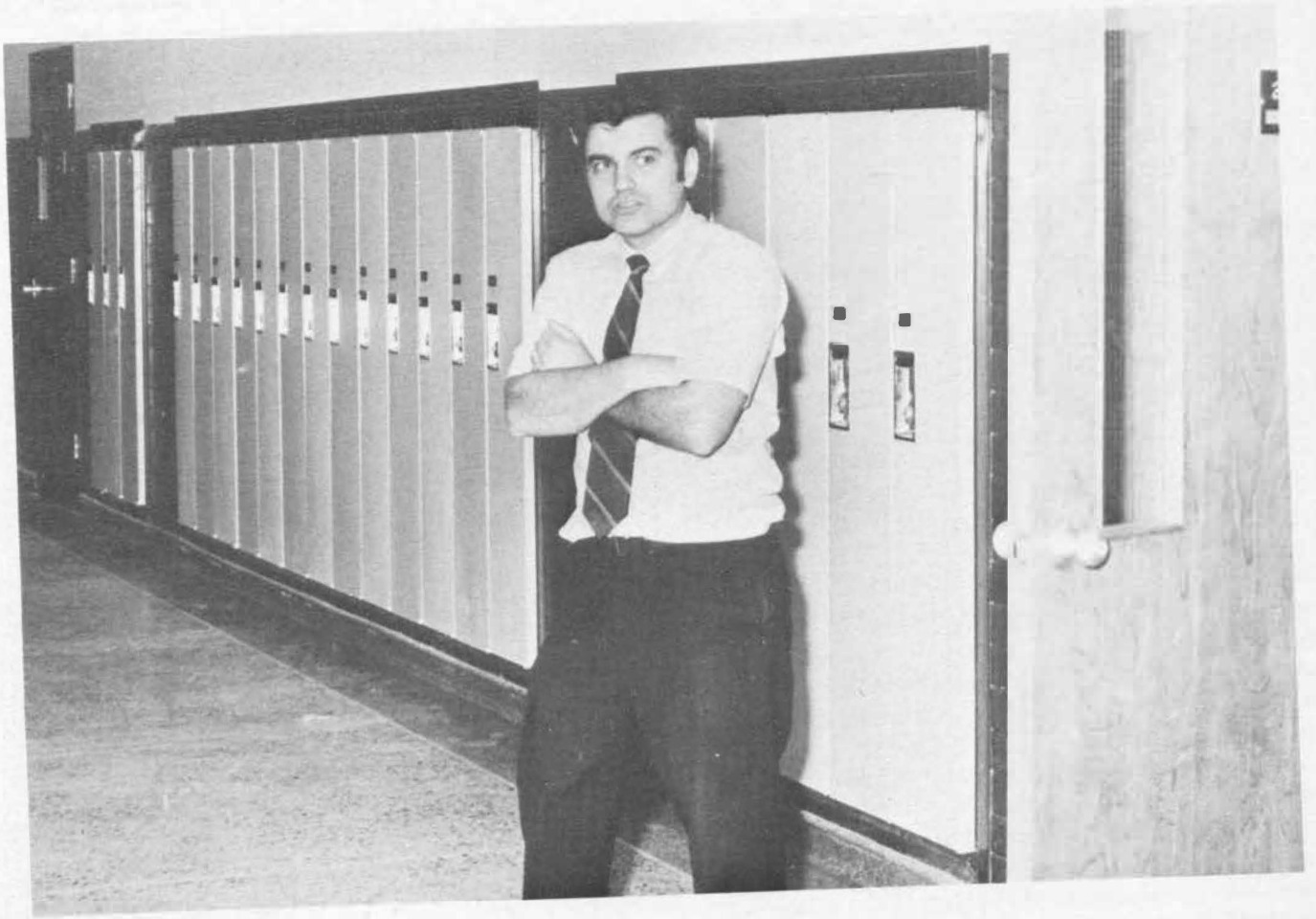
In closing, we would like to express our deepest thanks to our hard working staff and our advisor, Mr. Renaud, to whom we are greatly indebted.

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

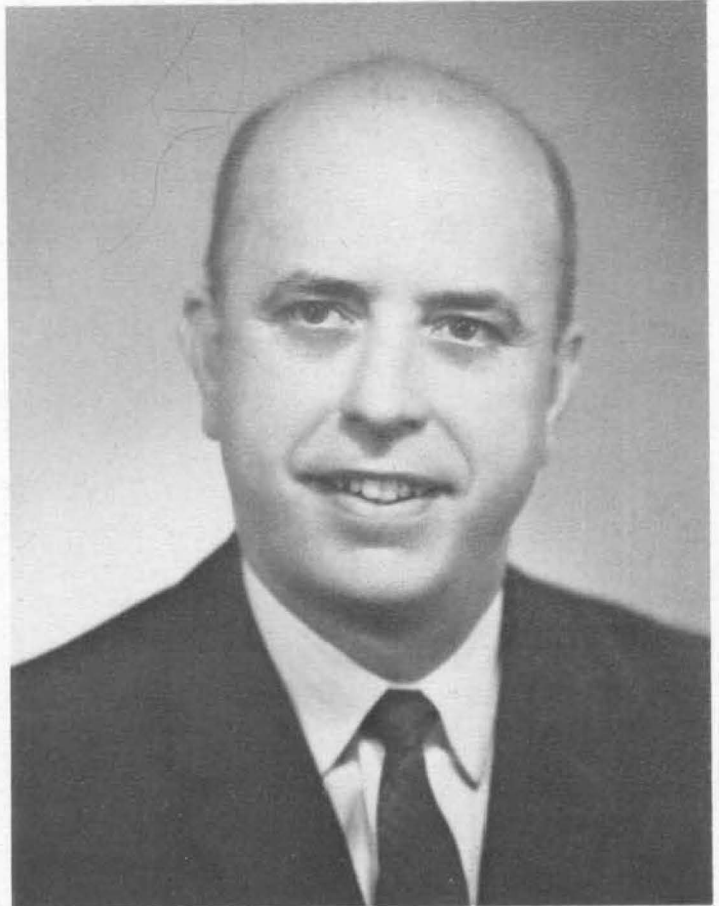
As usual, TOWERS has captured the excitement of an eventful and successful year.

It was an especially important year for me since I was eager to see how the wider selection of options and individual timetabling would work out. I am now convinced that the innovations have been good. They have given students greater freedom in the choice of their courses. They have permitted them, in both academic and technical courses, to follow their interests more closely. And I think they have led to a sense of achievement in a rich educational experience.

This year, I have enjoyed seeing learning as it went on in the free and relaxed atmosphere of shops and classrooms. I think that the future will see even more freedom and privileges for students. We, as teachers and administrators, sincerely want to have more faith and confidence in our students. We want to see them assuming greater responsibilities.

Let me develop this so as to explain my own point of view about student freedom and responsibility. I do believe in student government as a strong force within a school, not just as an instrument of the authority of the school. No students need ever apologize for requesting concessions which they may regard as privileges. But the avenue of request should be through the student government. Once the Student Council has weighed a request and approved it, the office will usually consider it sympathetically. Is it worthwhile? Can it be worked out successfully? Will it be properly supervised? Will the student body accept responsibility? These are some of the questions which I am likely to ask. This school year, students have instituted at least three large new projects, and I am proud of the responsibility which they have assumed.

I have been amused — and a little concerned too — at some of the criticism levelled at the Student Council this year. Criticism shows interest, and it is true that much of it was good-humoured; but still, I think that some of it was unfair, for I have admired our Student Council this year both for their concern and their action. Perhaps my feeling is best summed up by revising Shaw's famous aphorism to read, "Those who can, do: those who can't, criticize."



There has been a long tradition of goodwill at Lowe. One can appreciate it in looking at the very first yearbook which came out in 1925. The pictures are quaint to our eyes, but one can sense that same good spirit which is evident in the pages of this edition of TOWERS. The students then were proud of their new school. Thanks to extensive renovations and the provision of bright new lockers, I think that the school today has a wonderful air of newness about it. I am happy, too, in seeing that today's students are proud of their school.

This edition of TOWERS is one of the best in a series of yearbooks which stretches back over forty-five years. I speak for the teachers and students as well as for myself when I say that we are deeply grateful to the editors, Michael Meagher and Pat Rocca, and to their hard-working staff for this record of an eventful year.

I shall have a lot of pleasure in leafing through this book, but I know that my pleasure will be tinged with sadness as I see the names and faces of those who will be leaving us as graduates in June. But I rejoice in their accomplishment. I hope that we have prepared them well and that they will have good memories of their years here. Mr. Harrison, Mr. Neilson and all the teachers join me in saying farewell to them and in wishing them well.

From a moral standpoint, the past year was a resounding success; from a statistical outlook, it was a disheartening failure. Rather a paradoxical situation, you might say.

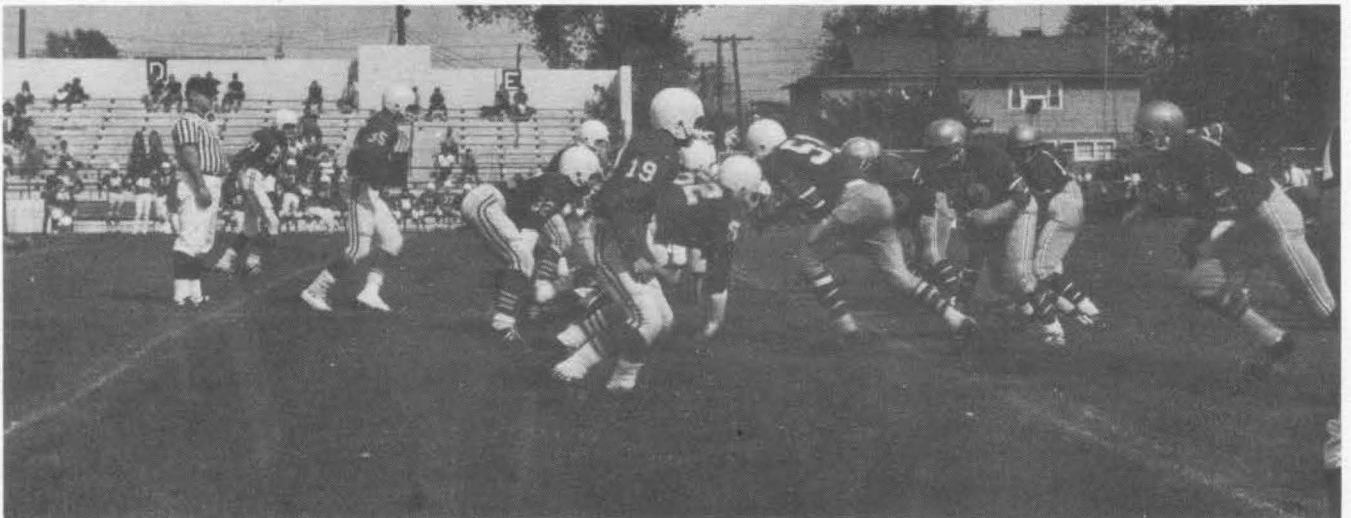

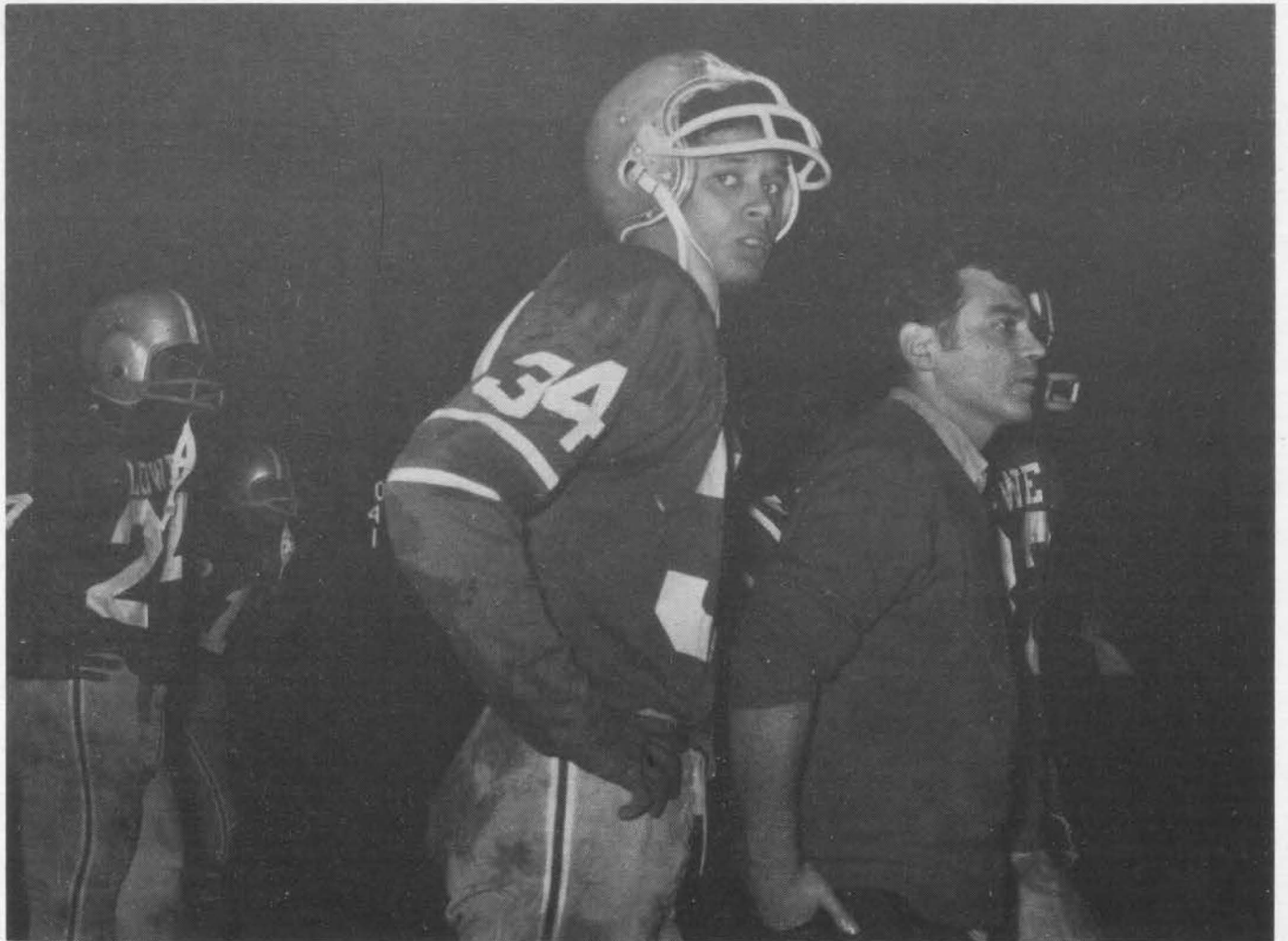
I would like to thank the Rough Riders for their dedicated spirit that they displayed throughout the season; you made a commitment and you kept it; that's what it is all about.

WHY?

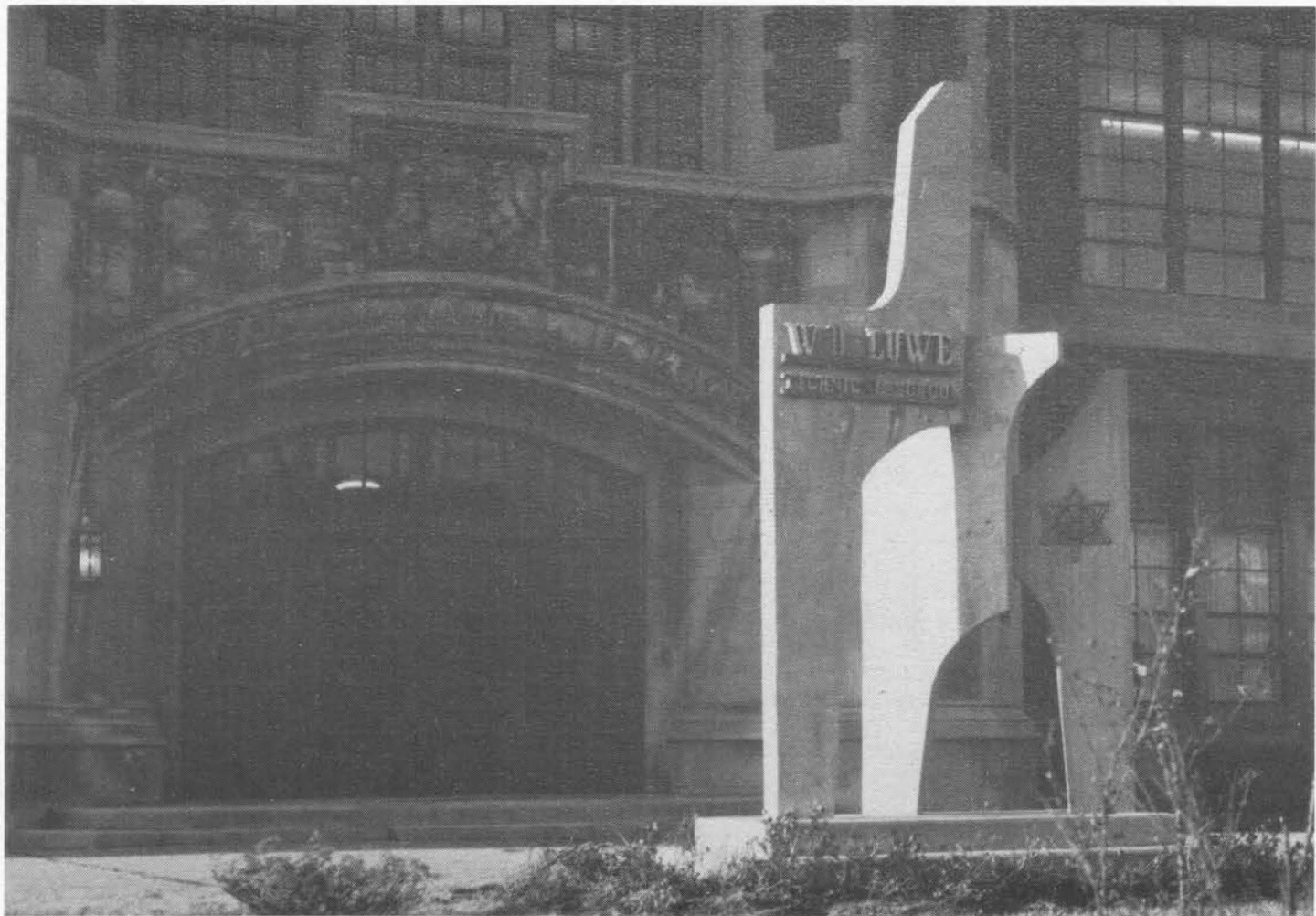
Was it a conflict of truth, of emotion or of human devotion?
