

You are hereby notified to meet at the School House in said Town on Tuesday, the 10th day of March next, at nine of the clock in the forenoon to act upon the following subjects:

 To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

2. To raise such sums of money as may be necessary to defray town charges for the ensuing year and make appropriation of the same.

3. To see if the Town will vote to accept State Aid for Highways and raise and appropriate the amount required by law to secure the same.

4. To see if the Town will vote to adopt the provisions of the Municipal Budget Act.

5. To see if the Town will vote to authorize Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.

6. To see if the Town will vote to have driveways ploughed and raise money for the same.

7. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.
