- 10. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$21.45 to the White Mountain Region Association.
- 11. To see what sums of money the town will vote to raise and appropriate for payment and interest on Light Line Note.
- 12. To see if the town will vote to have the State Tax Commission assess the property in the town, and raise and appropriate the sum of \$750. for the expense of the same.
- 13. To see what action the town will take in regard to the following article "Shall the provisions of Chapter 171-A of the Revised Laws relative to playing Beano be adopted in this town?"
- 14. To see if the town will authorize the Selectmen to borrow money in anticipation of Taxes.
- 15. To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.

To the Inhabitants of the School District, in the Town of Wentworth Location in the County of Coos, qualified to vote in district affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Town Hall, in said district, on Tuesday, the 12th day of March, 1957, immediately after town meeting, to act upon the following articles:

- 1. To choose a Moderator for the ensuing year.
- 2. To choose a Clerk for the ensuing year.
- 3. To choose a member of the School Board for the ensuing three years.
- 4. To choose a Treasurer for the ensuing year.
- 5. To hear the reports of Agents, Auditors, Committees or Officers heretofore chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.

agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the district, and to authorize the application against said appropriation of such sums as are estimated to be received from the state equalization fund together with other income; the school board to certify to the selectmen the balance between the estimated revenue and the appropriation, which balance is to be raised by taxes by the town.

9. To transact any other business that may lawfully come before said meeting.
